Gullett Elementary shall offer one (1) \$1,000.00 Scholarship

The applicant must meet <u>all</u> of the following requirements for the scholarship:

- 1) Attends and will graduate from a high school within the Austin Independent School District
- 2) Former Gullett Elementary student with at least three years of attendance at Gullett
- 3) Graduating high school senior who will continue their education, via Vocational School, Junior College or a four year University
- 4) Achieved a cumulative GPA of 2.50 or greater at the time of application completion
- 5) Demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activities and/or community service-based organizations

Submission process:

- Complete application packages must be submitted no later than May 1st, 2022 via email to: <u>President@gullettgeckos.com</u>; Subject line: Scholarship - Applicants Last Name
- All required documents must be submitted together, at the same time, in one pdf file to be considered
- Incomplete packages will be disqualified

Review Process:

- Scholarship award decision will be based on a combination of academic performance, extracurricular/community service participation, essay content & completeness, letters of recommendation, and fulfillment of application requirements
- The applications will be reviewed by the Gullett Principal, PTA President and Treasurer, and a recipient will be chosen
- The Scholarship recipient will be notified no later than one week prior to the awards ceremony. The recipient will be honored at a ceremony at the school (date TBD), where the recipient will be asked to say a few words to the current Gullett Elementary students.

What lessons did you learn, and how did it shape you as a person, student and member of the community? 2) Which Gullett teacher had the most influence on you and why? How did he/she contribute to your education and your subsequent contributions to your school, family and community? Three (3) Letters of Recommendation with each letter containing specific criteria for content:

 Letter from a personal reference who has first-hand knowledge of the candidate on a more personal level (not a family member). This letter <u>must</u> contain information about the personal qualities and characteristics of the candidate that make them the best choice for the Scholarship.

Letter from either a teacher or counselor who has first-hand knowledge of the candidate. This letter <u>must</u> contain - candidate's overall participation in his/her education, academic standing and characteristics possessed by candidate that make him/her the best candidate

Letter from either extracurricular or community service work contact who has first-hand knowledge of the candidate. This letter <u>must</u> contain information about the candidate's participation/achievements in his/her organization, and characteristics possessed by the
