# **How to choose 9th Grade Classes**

# **Core Classes (Pick 4 each year):**

## **English:**

• English I - Pre-AP or Regular (has a STAAR test)

## **Social Studies:**

• World Geography - Pre-AP or Regular

#### Science:

You have 3 choices:

- Integrated Physics and Chemistry (IPC)- Regular (easiest)
- Integrated Physics and Chemistry (IPC) Honors (*Not as hard as Bio and no STAAR test*)
- Pre-AP Biology (Rigorous and has a STAAR test)

#### Math:

- If you are currently in 8th grade math, choose:
  - o Algebra I AND Strategic Learning Pre-AP or Regular (STAAR test)
- If you are currently in Algebra I, choose:
  - o Geometry Pre-AP or Regular
- If you are currently in Geometry, choose:
  - o Algebra II Pre-AP or Regular

# **Elective Classes:**

# **Language Other Than English:**

Students are required to take 2 year of a Language Other Than English though we recommend more. It is good for your brain, GPA/rank and colleges love it!

#### **Guidelines:**

- 1. If you have already started a language, we suggest that you continue.
- 2. If you have not yet started your language, you can start your 9th grade year or wait until 10th grade year. It is up to you. Consider the difficulty of your course load when making your decision.

# Band, Choir, Orchestra and Dance Classes (including majors):

Just choose any of these classes. Your teachers will tell us where to put you in the fall.

#### **P.E.:**

Students are required to take 1 year of P.E. sometime during their High School years. You do not have to take a P.E. as a freshman, but it is a good idea.

You may choose a sport, a P.E. class or an alternate P.E.

- Sports choose both a fall and spring semesters
- P.E. classes
  - o Aerobic Conditioning regular gym
  - o Individual Sports bowling, badminton etc.
  - o Aerobic Dance Dance 1
- Alternate P.E. (Marching Band, Drill Team, Color Guard, Cheerleading)
- Off Campus P.E. (see AISD website)

## First class in a Sequence:

These classes are <u>very important</u> because they are the FIRST class in a sequence of classes and must be taken BEFORE taking any of the upper level sequence classes.

#### Art 1

- First class in all visual art classes such as drawing, painting, ceramics, sculpture, printmaking.
- Can take in middle school for High School Credit. If so, eligible for all upper level art classes.

## **Principles of Art/AV**

- First class for Graphic Arts, Animation, Video Game Design, AV/Cinematic Arts, and Commercial Photography.
- Can take in middle school for High School Credit. If so, eligible for upper level classes.

## **Principals of Applied Engineering**

• First class in the Engineering Architecture strand

### **Business Information Management**

• First class in the Accounting Strand

## Photojournalism

• First class in the Newspaper or Yearbook strand
